

Dragoo Adventure Rider Training

Missouri Clinic October 21-22, 2017

Dispel the myth that your bike is too big.

Aspiring adventure riders will learn to manage heavy dual sport motorcycles over rough terrain safely and efficiently. Lessons focus on skills that help you get where you're going off pavement, and you will look good in the process.

- If you find yourself hesitating to follow the gang through deep sand, up steep, rutted hills, or if you despise reversing course on that narrow trail when the leader misses a turn; this clinic is for you.
- If you're a "pretty good rider," but would like to sharpen your skills on the big bike, this clinic is for you.
- If you would like to throw a sleeping bag on your dual sport machine and explore but don't have the confidence to make it happen, this clinic is for you.

- Geared toward DR, KLR, GS and KTM Adventure class motorcycles, 650CC and up, but smaller machines are welcome.
- Entry level riders interested in improving their skills do well on 250CC machines such as the Super Sherpa, TTR & XT 225 and 250.
- ***This will be an action-packed two days, plus a meet and greet on Oct. 20th 6:00 pm at Engle Motors BMW/Triumph. Don't miss it!***

Skill training will include but not be limited to:

Balance and control	Towing * Level 2
Proper body position	Trailside Emergency Including Flat Repair (time permitting)
Proper use of brakes where traction is marginal	Clutch not crutch. How not to dab or fall when you think there is no alternative.
Skid turns	Sand Extraction * Level 2
Obstacle Crossing * Level 2	Negotiating deep sand * Level 2
Tight turns	Riding Gear Selection
Hill Fail Turnaround	Luggage options

* Level 2 lessons subject to conditions and class progression.

Cost: \$425.00 (\$395 for first 5 registrations in August, \$395 if you register with a riding buddy) , includes park fees and lunch both days.
